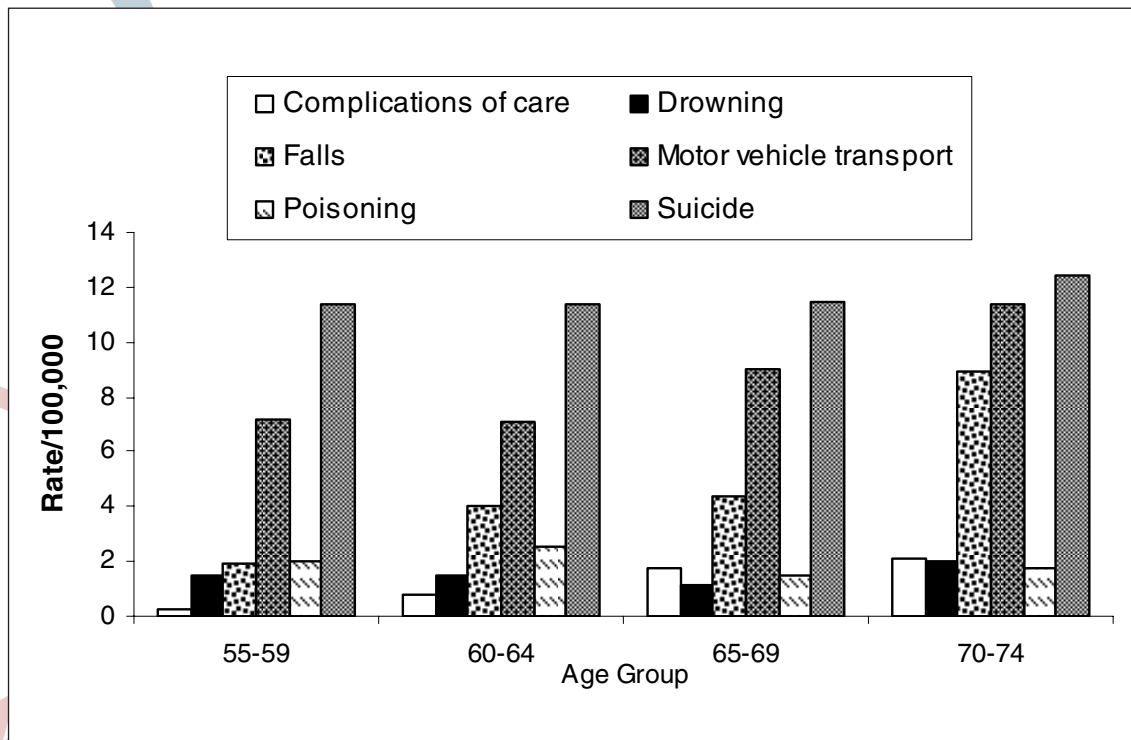


INJURY DEATH RATES IN PEOPLE AGED 55-74 YEARS IN NEW SOUTH WALES BY CAUSE OF INJURY: 1998-2002



- Suicide was the leading cause of injury death.
- Motor vehicle transport and falls were the second and third leading causes of injury death
- The death rate due to falls increased with age
